Students must have a minimum Cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 2.7 to co-register for EDFN 338, SPED 296 and TET 200, and a CGPA of 2.7 to be eligible to apply for Teacher Education admission. Students must have a score of 150-Math, 156-Reading, 162-Writing in the3 areas of the PRAXIS CORE prior to admission to Teacher Education (www.ets.org). Students must be admitted into Teacher Education to enroll in Junior Year courses.
